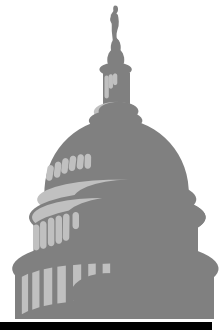

The Washington Metropolitan Area Division of the Polish American Congress is sponsoring two participants to the Youth Leadership Conference of the American Council for Polish Culture, being held in Washington, DC, June 20-26, 2010. The Division is covering the full Conference fee of \$500 for one person and half the Conference fee for a second person.

At the Division's Annual Meeting on June 13, 2010, it was announced that, as a result of the competition announced earlier, the Division will be sponsoring the participation of Max Korzan and Jan Pawel Stefanski in the Conference.

Max Korzan is a 2010 graduate of the International Baccalaureate Program of Richard Montgomery High School, Maryland. He attended the Saturday Polish School at Our Lady Queen of Poland and St. Maximilian Kolbe Parish grades K-10, where he also served as a teacher's aide. Max did summer community service in Nicaragua in 2007 and participated in World Youth Days 2008 in Sydney, Australia. He is the son of Division members Slawomir and Sylvia Korzan, of Silver Spring, MD.

Jan Pawel Stefanski has completed his sophomore year at the University of Chicago, majoring in economics. Jan has held internships at the Brookings Institution, the John Paul II Cultural Center, and the Jan Karski Institute.
